First Lady Designates Four New Preserve America Stewards

Washington, D.C.—First Lady of the United States Michelle Obama has signed designation letters for four new Preserve America Stewards, bringing the total nationwide to 34.

“Preserve America Stewards are volunteer programs that have accomplished successful efforts in preserving the nation’s historic places,” said Wayne Donaldson, chairman of the federal Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). “Historic preservation has always relied upon motivated, active volunteers who understand that it is an individual as well as community responsibility to make certain that significant historic places remain to enrich and enlighten present and future generations.”

 In recognition of its preservation of the Cascade Historic City Jailhouse &
 Cascade Historic Limestone Silo
- Maryland: **Friends of Jerusalem Mill**
 In recognition of its preservation of Jerusalem Mill Village
- Nebraska: **Douglas County Historical Society**
 In recognition of its Douglas County Historical Society Volunteer Program
- Texas: **Texas Historical Commission**
 In recognition of its RIP Guardian Program
